## Junior & Youth Camp 2009

\* **REGISTRATION** BEGINS AT 2:00 P.M. MONDAY JULY 13, 2009

1. Rules for acceptance and participation in this camp are the same without regards to race, color, age, national origin, sex or handicap.
2. There will be a nurse on campgrounds for any minor injuries or sickness.
3. If camper should leave camp due to emergency, 50 % of camp fee will be refunded if camper leaves before Wednesday at 6p.m. Homesickness does not constitute as emergency.
4. Each camper is given a bunk and mattress, but must provide his/her own bedding and personal belongings such as towels, soap and flashlight, insect repellent, etc, be prepared for cold weather at night.
5. Camp cannot be responsible for lost or stolen articles, but will establish a lost and found center. Unclaimed articles will be given away if not claimed after 30 days.
6. **BOYS:** All boys are to dress modestly at all times. Swimming attire will only be allowed in private pool area. Casual, yet appropriately modest clothes are to be worn during the evening services. Boy's hairstyle and dress are to conform to the standard set by the SoCal District UPC for Senior Youth Camp, which is as follows:  
"In keeping with the spirit of the camp, boys shall not wear clothing that is tight or revealing. All shirts must have modest sleeves. No shorts are to be worn outside of the swimming area. We ask that all boys have a well-groomed haircut. In keeping with the unity in the District, there will be no facial hair allowed. We ask that no tattoos, or jewelry (such as rings, earrings, necklaces, bracelets, etc.) be worn."
7. **GIRLS:** All girls are to dress modestly at all times. Swimming attire will only be allowed in private pool area. Casual, yet appropriately modest clothes are to be worn during the evening services. Girls dress is to conform to the standard set by SoCal District UPC for Senior Youth Camp, which is as follows:  
"In keeping with the spirit of the camp, girls shall not wear clothing that is tight or revealing. Skirts and dresses are to cover the knee, and dresses and blouses must have modest sleeves (no cap sleeves will be permitted). Gauchos will not be permitted. Culottes will not be permitted since there are so many varied opinions among the constituency. No skirts or dresses with slits above the knee. Necklines should be decent and modest. Also, no capris, slacks, shorts, etc., will be allowed. We ask that no makeup, tattoos, or jewelry (such as rings, earrings, necklaces, bracelets, etc.) be worn."
8. Each camper is expected to share in the workload of the camp.
9. Foul language, disrespect, or continual misbehavior is grounds for dismissal from camp. If dismissed, no refund will be given.
10. The camp will have a snack bar, so bring extra money.
